Tasting notes

Full-bodied and fruit-forward with blueberry notes as well as tasting a bit juicy. Behind the fruit there are faint hints of perfume and orange zest as well as an underlying smell of gravel.

Winemaking notes:

The grapes come from vineyards of more than 25 years. Harvested by hand.

Maceration of six days after fermentation, this wine has a light oak aging of 3 months
